Kasana Museum is the result of archaeological and cultural research in the spring of 2008. It is also the first museum in the Upper West Region of Ghana. The museum is housed in a traditional village, which offers the visitor a unique experience. In and around the village are old settlement mounds, cisterns, heaps of iron slag and other ancient remains in an un-spoilt landscape. Kasana is famous for its old slave market and evocative dances inspired by mating birds and still performed.

On the Burkina Faso side of the frontier are the wonderful Animal Parks of the Forêt de Sissili & Ranch de Nazinga.
